- Applicants should have between 13 and 15 Advanced Level points.
- Priority shall be given to orphans and students on Basic Education Assistance Module (BEAM).
- Application should be accompanied by supporting letters from both the primary and secondary school heads.
- Application should also be accompanied by supporting letters from Headman and Chief, who shall support what the school authorities would have provided as proof of the indigent position of the student.
- Female students who meet the selection criteria are highly encouraged to apply.
