Setting up Google Scholar Profile

1. Go to www.scholar.google.com/citations
2. Sign in with your Google Account. If you do not yet have a Google account, you can create one here: <https://accounts.google.com/signup>
3. You will reach the following page






Add Articles to your Profile

Follow these steps to add articles and other publications to your profile.

Step 1 Click on the highlighted icon. It gives you a dropdown menu of options of how to add articles. Articles can be automatically added from Google Scholar or manually.



Step 2 Google will provide a list of articles that are believed to be written by you. Select the relevant articles and click the blue arrow at the top left of the page to add the article(s) to your profile.



To add articles that are not indexed by Google Scholar, select the option 'Add article manually' on Step 1. You will be presented with a form below, select the type of publication and populate the form. Click the blue arrow at the top left of the page to add the article(s) to your profile.
